* notes James Aldous was the People's then Rector's Warden of St Mary Redenhall for 35 years from 1819 to 1854. We have a copy of minutes of 28 Mar 1853 vestry meeting which re-elected him for the last time as it transpired. Also, the Churchwardens' Accounts and Vestry Minutes for the period 1852-1928 (ref. PD 295/87) are on microfilm MF 1863.

There is also a c100 page-side "Memo Book" for Redenhall Parish (reference PD/295/105), which includes the minutes of Town Meetings from 1820-1850. We have photo images of just over 40 of its page sides.

We have photos and transcriptions of all the Redenhall family graves.

Notes Alex Aldous was apprenticed to Edmd. Stokes, a wine and spirit merchant in Portsea - presumably organized by his dad who was wine merchant, brewer, inn-keeper etc in Harleston. Alex probably took over the Stokes' business. He was eventually supplying grog to the Royal Navy in Portsmouth (one of his Executors was the chief paymaster of the Royal Navy).

The Swards were successful Yeoman tenant farmers in Weston, near Buriton (Hampshire). Hops, Grains, Wool, and Lime were amongst the products from around 800 acres of land they managed. Elizabeth's mother was the daughter of a successful London builder, whose residence was near the junction of Oxford St and Tottenham Court Rd!

Alex's first marriage to Elizabeth Seward ended tragically when Scarlett Fever laid her low on Christmas Day 1862 aged 37, along with one of their children, and leaving behind Florence (4) and **George** (1) . He was remarried 4 years' later to someone 20 years his junior, but never found happiness. His grave is in his father's spiritual home - St Mary, Redenhall (Nr Harleston, Norfolk).
