and Administrators firmly by these Presents Sealed with our Seals
Dated the 1 second Day of September in the
third Year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord
George the third by the Grace of God of Great
Brittain, Ireland King Defender of the Faith and
so forth, And in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Seven
Hundred and Seventy Three.

The Condition of this Obligation is such, That if the above bound
Hambley the Daughter of John Hambley Administrator of all and singular the Goods Chattels
and Credits of William James late of Freony deceased do
make or cause to be made a true and perfect Inventory of all and singular the Goods
Chattels and Credits of the said deceased which have or shall come to the Wands,
Possession or Knowledge of her the said Anne Hambley
or into the Wands and Possession of any Person or Persons for her and
the same do exhibit or cause to be exhibited into the Registry of the Diocess of Down
