 Captain in the Service of the Honorable
 East India Company in their Madras
 establishment now deceased being of sound
 and disposing mind, memory and understanding
 do make and publish and declare this as and
 for and to be my last Will and Testament in
 manner following that is to say I direct that
 all my lawful debts funeral and Testamentary
 expences be paid and satisfied by my Executors
 hereinafter named and appointed from and
 out of my personal estate only. I give and
 bequeath unto my beloved Sister Paulina,
 Petriavella, Woodchow, my Executrix hereinafter
 named, from and out of the monies standing
 in my name, in the Madras Government
 Savings Bank the sum of Company's Paper
 two hundred should she be desirous of accepting
 the same for her own absolute benefit, but
 in the event of my beloved Sister declining
 to accept that amount, then that sum is
 to form part of the residue of my said estate
 and to be dealt with and disposed of by my
 Executors as hereinafter provided for. Whereas
 my family consists of Justa Amy Sophia Locke
 now of the age of twenty seven years Agnes
 Laura Locke now of the age of twenty three years
 Henry Saville Montague Locke now of the age of
 twenty two years. Alfred Percival Locke, now of

of the age of twenty years. Laura Camilla Locke
 now of the age of eighteen years Julia Eliza Locke
 now of the age of seventeen years & Eliza Charlotte
 Gertrude Locke, now of the age of twelve years,
 all unmarried and unprovided for, and with
 the desire and intention to make a provision for
 their support, maintenance and education
 I do hereby bequeath and devise unto my Executors
 hereinafter named all and singular that my
 freehold house messuages and tenement situated
 in Hunters' Street No. 8. Vepery, Madras, and now
 in my occupation and enjoyment together
 with the out houses and appurtenances thereto
 belonging the same having been obtained
 acquired and purchased by me with certain
 monies raised by subscriptions by my friends
 after my dear Husband's decease and as
 and for a provision for myself and my said
 family my deceased Husband's estate at the
 time of his death, being wholly insolvent, and
 all and singular my goods and Chattels and
 personal estate of what nature or kind soever
 both present and to come. To hold the same
 upon the trusts and for the purposes hereinafter
 mentioned, that is to say upon trust that my
 Executrix hereinafter named do stand
 possessed of all my household furniture plate
 Jewels and Trinkets for the use and enjoyment
 of all my said Children, so long as they
 may agree among themselves, to use and
 enjoy the same but in the event of any
 disagreement or difference among my said
 Children with reference thereto and four
 of them being of the age of twenty one years

years should agree that the same should be sold
 in such case and with all convenient speed
 my said Executrix is to sell & dispose of and Convert
 into ready money all such part or parts of my
 personal Estate as shall not at the time of my
 decease consist of ready money. And also upon
 Trust that my Executrix hereinafter named,
 do and shall manage my aforesaid House
 now in my Occupation in such manner
 as she may deem most fitting for the advantage
 and benefit of my said Family, either by my
 said Family continuing to reside together in
 the said House or by renting the same or by
 absolute sale and disposal thereof, either by
 public auction or by private Contract. And
 upon further trust that my said Executrix
 hereinafter named shall and do stand
 possessed of and interested in the rents or
 purchase money to arise by the letting or by
 the sale of the said messuage and tenement
 and ^{the same} together with the residue of my personal
 Estate upon the trusts for the intents and purposes
 hereinafter expressed and declared, that is to say,
 in trust for such of my said several Children
 living at the time of my decease and of the
 age of twenty One years or such of them as shall
 attain to the age of twenty One years, equally to
 be divided between them, share and share
 alike. And from and after the decease of any
 of my said Children, do and shall assign
 and transfer his or her respective share of
 the residue of my Estate unto and amongst
 all and every Survivor or Survivors of my

my said Children. And I do hereby nominate,
 constitute and appoint my beloved Sister
 Paulina Petronella Woodhouse, sole Executrix
 of this my last Will and Testament hereby
 revoking and making void all former and
 other Wills by me at any time heretofore
 made, and I declare this to be my only true
 last Will and Testament. In witness whereof
 I have hereunto set and affixed my Hand
 and Seal at Madras aforesaid this twenty first
 day of June, in the year of Our Lord One
 thousand eight hundred and fifty seven.
